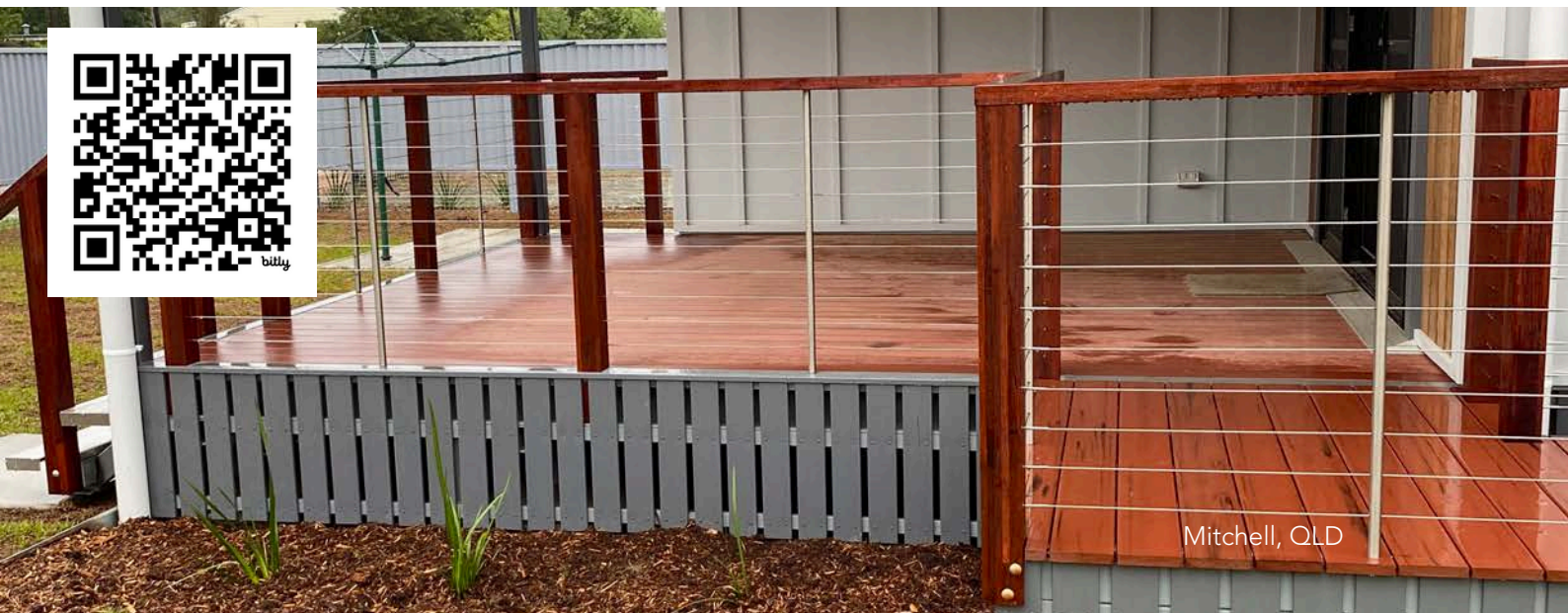

Delivered mid-2023 to St George, Injune and Mitchell in western Queensland, the homes aimed to relieve the pressure on the housing supply in regional areas of the state.

Modular construction is part of the modern methods of construction, which is a technique distinguished by a significant reduction in construction waste, faster delivery and limited time onsite. This was the first housing alliance between Ausco Modular and QBuild.
